EarthCheck, also know as Green Globe until 2009, is the first worldwide certification program developed for the tourism industry.

Le Novotel Paris Les Halles has been engaged in the process for severals months, and the EarthCheck label now allows the hotel to guarantee its customer its commitment in sustainable development.

It was at the initiative of the hotel and through the involvement and mobilisation of all the teams at the Novotel Paris Les Halles that the hotel was able to embark on this adventure and to obtain the certification. A year of preparation and 10 months of evaluation were necessary to receive this precious label which is accepted by an independent auditor. It is then checked and reassessed every 2 years.

Since the launch of the Earth Checked certification process, the Novotel Paris Les Halles has obtained encouraging results and has introduced actions such as:

- Reduction in electricity consumption of 6.88%
- Installation of energy saving lamps in lit spaces 24h/24
- Installation of water flow regulators on taps and showers
- Recycling of paper, glass, bulb, cardboard and batteries
- Greater use of products from organic farming and/ or local production
- Use of recycled paper
- Low energy bulb used in 80% of the hotel
- Recycling of fats and oils
- Bio label welcoming products and green cleaning products
- Exterior lighting set to the astronomical clock
- Bathroom linen changed at the client's request, and savings allocated to reforestation projects selected by the Group worldwide
- Green waste deposited in acompost factory

- Climate system integrating a heat recovery for the water system
- Energy recovery system
- Training and education of staff

How does an hotel obtain the Earth Check certification?

Step 1: the hotel volunteers

Step 2: Earth Check examines and evaluates the performance of the hotel in 8 fields (the establishment of a sustainable development policy, water consumption, energy consumption, waste management, and use of pesticides, use of cleaning and hygiene products, commitment vis-à-vis local communities).

Step 3: from the performance evaluation, the hotel sets up an action plan and rules to improve its weaknesses and reach their objectives as fixed by EarthCheck

Step 4: if these actions allow the hotel to improve its performances and meet the EarthCheck requirement, the hotel is certified by external and independent auditors.
